The children leave for mid-winter break beginning on Wednesday, Feb. 13<sup>th</sup> and do not return until Tuesday, the 19<sup>th</sup>. They missed two days of school this past week with no lunch and breakfast, so we are a little concerned with the forecasted weather and trying to gather enough food items.
