



DIRECTOR OF YOUTH MINISTRIES – Job Description

Responsibilities:

- Design and implement engaging ministry that inspires students to grow in faith, love, and service. Middle School Youth (Grades 6 – 8) and High School Youth (Grades 9 – 12).
- Equip, call, organize, train, and encourage volunteers & parents for effective ministry
- Collaborate with Children’s and Youth Ministry Committee along with Elder support.
- Integrate Youth Ministry program within the whole life of the church.
- Lead Sunday morning Youth education program across both age groups, assisted by volunteers where appropriate.
- Lead regular evening and/or weekend Youth group meetings for both Middle School and High School groups respectively.
- Ensure risk management and child protection policies are established, maintained, and enforced, including compliance with all applicable legal requirements.
- Meet with other church staff and volunteers to plan, oversee, and support programs and events, including but not limited to Mission, recreational and worship-related activities.
- Lead Remote Youth Group gatherings via online or social media platforms.

Qualifications:

- Commitment to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior through actions and lifestyle
- Experience with Youth faith development and evidence of teaching skills in an age-appropriate context.
- Solid interpersonal communication skills, supporting and providing a safe and nurturing environment for inquisitive minds
- Capacity to motivate, connect with, and inspire the Youth and Families
- Ability to recruit, train, and encourage volunteers and parents
- Demonstrate proficiency with digital platforms for online ministry gatherings and communication with students.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Degree in Christian education or teaching certification (or in-process), or equivalent qualifications / experience.
- Previous leadership experience with Children’s and/or Youth Activities in some capacity.

Benefits: Working hours will be 25 hours per week, with an expectation of flexibility to accommodate seasonal variations. Final weekly work schedule must be negotiated with Pastor. Position includes 3 weeks paid leave and small stipend for job-related continuing education. Job duties can be expanded to meet Seminary degree internship requirements if necessary.
